Motion by Todd Reeves to pay bills as presented totaling \$44,764.54 was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried.

Motion by Trish Heim to approve the agenda with removal of Levi Kisner was seconded by Rick Towers and carried.

Mayor reported that he had talked to Union Pacific Railroad employee regarding rough crossings and removal of grain bins. Railroad employee recommended that calls to the phone number posted at the crossings would help to get faster action on repairs to the crossings. Employee also noted that he would request that supervisor in charge of area contact Mayor regarding grain bins.

Council inquired about any building plans in Industrial Park for Rossville Christian Church. No information has been filed.

Council thanked Chief Sipp for contacting owner of property at 515 Main about weeds and noted that area had been cleaned up.

Utility Superintendent Alan Zlatnik present quote from Approved Paving to make repairs at Anderson and Orange Streets. Following discussion council requested that utility department put gravel as temporary base to widen area for now and will look at asphalting when doing city wide street repairs in spring.

Superintendent Zlatnik reported that he was getting prices on new Ferris mower and that he would like to purchase coats for his department. Motion by Rick Towers to approve purchase of coats was seconded by Trish Heim and carried.

Police Chief Thomas Sipp reported on VIN inspection training, nuisance violation notices issued for inoperable vehicles, no new information regarding highway 24 crosswalk signals, background checks for peddlers, working with Code Enforcement Officer Jeffrey Overmyer on permit violations in the City of Willard, trunk n treat turnout and meeting with Sheriff regarding license readers. Chief Sipp also presented bids for new car and body cameras. Following discussion motion by Todd Reeves to approve bid from Axon at cost of \$49,765.00 was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried. Chief Sipp requested approval to work part time for KSU during football or basketball games. Council approved.

Council discussed the increase police patrol at the north Main Street area.

Council discussed proposed dates and menu for holiday dinner. Mayor to check with the Rossville American Legion Post #31 on dates. Clerk to look into caterer.

Clerk presented request for donation to project prom. Motion by Dan Glotzbach to donate \$250.00 was seconded by Trish Heim and carried.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to adjourn was seconded by Trish Heim carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:11pm.
