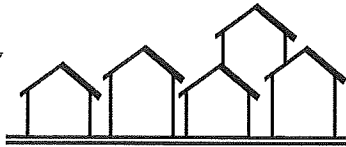

ORDINANCE NO. 835

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CODE SECTIONS 3-114 AND 3-305 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF ROSSVILLE, KANSAS REGULATING THE DATES AND TIMES OF RETAIL SALES OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR AND CEREAL MALT BEVERAGES IN THE CITY OF ROSSVILLE, KANSAS

BE IT ORDAINED by the governing body of the City of Rossville, Kansas:

SECTION 1. The Code of the City of Rossville, Kansas shall be amended by changing the following sections and verbiage set forth in Chapter III. Article 3-114. BUSINESS REGULATIONS to read as follows:

(c) No cereal malt beverages may be sold or dispensed between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m., or consumed between the hours of 12:30 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. or on Sunday except as provided for in subsection (d).

(d) Cereal malt beverages may be sold at retail in the original package on any Sunday between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. except Easter Sunday.

SECTION 2. The Code of the City of Rossville, Kansas shall be amended by changing the following sections and verbiage set forth in Chapter III Article 3-305. HOURS OF SALE to read as follows:

(a) No person authorized to sell any alcoholic liquor at retail within the city shall sell any alcoholic liquor before 9:00 a.m. or after 11:00 p.m. on any day when the sale thereof is permitted, except as provided in subsection (b).

(b) Sale at retail of alcoholic liquor in the original package is allowed within the City on Sunday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. except Easter Sunday.

(c) No sales of alcoholic liquor shall be permitted on Easter Sunday, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect 61 days after final publication, unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed, requiring a referendum to be held on the ordinance as provided in K.S.A. 41-2911, in which case this ordinance shall become effective upon approval by a majority of the electors voting thereon.


